

***Clinical neurological manifestations and associated surgical interventions*** <sup>9,10</sup>

<b><i>Associated medical conditions</i></b>	<b><i>Management/treatment</i></b>
Joint stiffness	Carpal tunnel syndrome and trigger finger, treated through neurosurgical decompression surgery Corrective orthopaedic surgery for kyphoscoliosis
Bone symptoms	Orthopaedic surgery to correct spinal deformities
Spinal cord compression	Decompression surgery
Seizures (MPS I, MPS II)	Decompression and rachis stabilisation for spinal cord compression
Mental retardation (MPS I-H, MPS II, MPS II)	Ventricular peritoneal shunt for communicating hydrocephalous
